General requirements	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Only essential travel: transit, work, studies, medical treatment, funerals, family reunion, return to place of residence, accompanying a minor; - Documental reason approval to the State Border Control and/or State Police on request; - Mandatory 10 days of self-isolation if travelling from high-risk public health threat countries (updated on Fridays). 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Permitted if not leaving the airside; - Boarder control. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Permitted, passengers are not allowed to disembark; - No border controls and other procedures.
Flight	- Unlimited number of passengers to/from EU, EEZ, Switzerland, UK and non-Schengen.		
Crew	- Crew travels without restrictions (crew ID, GenDec).		
Flight permits	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mandatory flight permit issued by state authorities for all flight to/from Non-EU and for all flights with non-EU operator (MK260). - For all other flights - Flight notification to authorities. 		
Negatvie COVID-19 PCR test	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mandatory; - Must be done not earlier than 72h prior arriving to Latvia; - Exceptions for crew members and children under 11 y.o. - Vaccinated person is not a subject of exception; - All passengers from third countries, except UK and Ireland, should perform <u>additional Covid-19 test upon arrival</u> (there is a testing point at Riga Airport). In case of not performing the test or having positive test a mandatory isolation in an approved hotel is applied. This test is not required for transfer passengers, crew, and some other categories. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Mandatory. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> - Not mandatory if not leaving the aircraft.

<p>The Operator is responsible to inform passengers with the requirements and check compliance before departure (QR code and PCR tests).</p> <p>In case of non-compliance with the requirements the boarding must be denied.</p>
